The candidate will have expertise in Analytical Chemistry and Forensic Analysis Candidates should have a proven track record of research and scholarly activities, specifically in Analytical Chemistry and Forensic Analysis which will support the research and scholarly activities of the school. The person appointed will contribute strongly to teaching and assessing, particularly across the school's undergraduate programmes. In addition to teaching and research, the role will involve curriculum development, particularly the expansion and integration analytical chemistry into our programmes, programme management and administration, and pastoral care of students. An industry background and familiarisation with modern teaching and assessment methods including on-line teaching and assessment would be advantageous.
