# Youth Work Assistant

### **Application Details**

Eligibility to participate on CE is generally linked to those who are 21 years or over and in receipt of a qualifying social welfare payment for 1 year or more or 18 years and over for certain disadvantaged groups. Your eligibility will have to be verified by the Department.

You can register your interest by selecting the 'Register your interest' button or you can contact an Employment Personal Advisor (EPA) in your local Intreo Centre.

Applicants should supply suitable character references and be prepared to complete a Garda vetting application form.

### **Job Description**

#### **Duties**

This is a developmental opportunity, no experience necessary. Accredited training will be provided to support your career.

To work with young people between the ages of 10 to 24 in a community setting, to be based between ETB building Killenaule and Community House Fethard.

Supervision of young people from 10 years upwards in various project groups, helping to facilitate a range of activities and programmes in areas such as Health Promotion, Sexual Health, Education, Sports, Hobbies / Interests, Music and Local / Regional / National Events.

There will be some administration work, facilitation of programmes, coaching of young people and opportunities for personal development.

It is especially suited to those who would like to pursue a career working with young people and teenagers in a community based setting.

Must be flexible with regards to hours as weekend and evening work involved.

Previous experience is not essential for this role as on the job and accredited training will be provided.
