Post Summary:

The School of Nursing & Midwifery, Trinity College Dublin is seeking to appoint an Assistant Professor in Midwifery. The primary purpose of this appointment is to contribute to midwifery education, research and administrative activities in the School. This appointment arises in response to the continued growth and development of the Midwifery profession within the School, and reflects a strategic commitment to expanding capacity, enhancing expertise, and building on Trinity College Dublin's leadership in Midwifery education and research.

Context:

We recognise the unique identity of the Midwifery profession and are committed to excellence in Midwifery practice, education, and research. The Midwifery team, in collaboration with colleagues across nursing and allied disciplines, actively contributes to advancing original and sustainable research in childbirth, reproductive health, and maternity care. This team places a strong emphasis on co-designed research with women and families, in partnership with clinical collaborators in our affiliated maternity hospitals, as well as national and international research networks and industry partners.

We are now seeking a motivated and talented Assistant Professor in Midwifery to join our growing team. The appointee will have a developing track record in Midwifery education and research and will be expected to contribute to undergraduate and postgraduate teaching, curriculum development, interdisciplinary education initiatives, and student supervision and research.
