Job Description

An Ergonomics Technician is required to work at UNIVERSAL SAFETY ASSOCIATES LIMITED, located at Unit 2, Glenrock Business Park, Ballybane, Galway, Co. Galway, H91 FF25. The candidate must hold a recognised qualification in ergonomics – a minimum Level 8 or 9 degree, or a Master's degree (or equivalent) – together with at least six months' experience in a dedicated ergonomics role. The successful applicant will be responsible for carrying out comprehensive ergonomic evaluations, recommending adjustments to workstations and processes, and collaborating with stakeholders to reduce musculoskeletal risks across a range of workplace settings. Key responsibilities will include undertaking full ergonomic assessments of employee workstations, processes and environments; identifying musculoskeletal risk factors using evidence-based assessment tools and methodologies; recommending tailored interventions, including workstation modifications, equipment specifications and workflow improvements; preparing clear and professional reports; and maintaining accurate records of evaluations and findings. The post-holder will also be expected to remain up to date with current research and best practice in ergonomics, human factors and workplace design.
