FIT have an exciting opportunity for female tech enthusiasts living in CORK and surrounding areas.

We are now accepting applicants for the i-FIT programme, with an opportunity to work with a leading company based in CORK. Successful candidates will be required to attend a number of in-person training days in DUBLIN throughout the two year programme.

Overview

The Software Development Apprenticeship is a two-year programme designed for those who have recently completed second-level education or mature learners seeking to retrain. It is a dual-education programme involving both college-based and workplace learning. This college-based learning is state funded and apprentices receive a salary (€312 per week - Year 1 and €408 per week - Year 2) from their employer while on the tech apprenticeship programme.

Why Choose a Tech Apprenticeship?

- Training is fully-funded, and learners earn a salary from the very beginning
- Gain hands-on technical experience with top companies in Ireland
- Successful completion of all modules on this programme results in the attainment of a Quality and Qualifications Ireland-accredited Advanced Certificate in Software Development, which is placed at Level Six on the National Framework of Qualifications
- On successful completion of the programme, qualified apprentices have the potential to progress into full-time positions with their employers or in some cases with a new technology employer.
