We are offering a supervised learning opportunity for a Volunteer Researcher to join our team. This placement is designed for individuals who want to develop research skills while contributing to social impact, health research, and evidence-based advocacy. You will work under the guidance of experienced team members, gaining hands-on experience in research methods, data analysis, and resource development.

What You Will Learn and Do

Learn how to conduct desk-based research on FASD-related topics, including health, education, and social care, with support from your supervisor.

Receive guidance on reviewing academic papers, policy documents, and international best practices, and practice summarising key insights.

Develop skills in compiling findings into clear reports and briefing notes, with feedback provided throughout.

Assist in creating resources for families, professionals, and policymakers, learning best practices in communication and advocacy.

Gain experience in data collection for ongoing projects and grant applications, supported by structured training.

Collaborate with the FASD Ireland team, learning how research aligns with organisational goals and impacts policy and awareness campaigns.
