To escort/Accompany residents to the hospital or for other appointments when directed by the senior nursing staff.

Assess and record vital signs and report any concerns to nursing team

Assess and record weights and MUST scores and report any concerns to nursing team

Participate in CPR and basic lifesaving and act as a first responder for the HCA team

Takes blood samples from residents/patients following phlebotomy training.
