- Set up and operate fabrication equipment including brake press, pinch rollers, pyramid rollers, and pipe benders.

- Collaborate with fitting teams on client sites (North Wicklow and Dublin) to assess fabrication requirements and provide accurate manual drawings for workshop execution.
- Liaise with laser and CNC departments to ensure precision fit and alignment in final assemblies.
- Maintain high safety and quality standards in all fabrication and site work.
