Candidates must have, on the closing date for receipt of applications the following minimum requirements:

A full, clean and current driving licence, category B & W. *(1),(2)

Note: ** (1) If your Irish driving licence is restricted to driving cars with an automatic transmission only (denoted by the code 78 appearing on the licence), you are not eligible.

(2) From 1 January 2021 if you are resident in Ireland and hold a UK/Ni driving licence it is no longer valid to drive on here in Ireland. It is not legal for driving purposes and must therefore be exchanged.
