Job Description

The key tasks include

- Assisting with sorting and grading textile/clothing items by separating into predetermined classifications (e.g., men's, women's, other textiles) and into quality levels (retail store grade, outlet grade, or salvage) and sort and grade household wares. The participant will work closely with the retail team to help collate merchandise for our vintage and pop up shops as well as our retail outlets.
