Sales Apprentice Training & Development

The apprenticeship is delivered through a blended learning approach, including:

- On-the-job training within the workplace, where apprentices will learn practical sales skills in a real business environment

- Off-the-job learning delivered by the Education and Training Board (ETB), consisting of:

 - Face-to-face workshops

Apprentices will be released from their normal work duties, where required, to attend all scheduled online learning and in-person training sessions.
