Summary of Requirements:

- * Successfully completed the Ishihara Colour Vision Test with a registered optician. Proof of this test must be emailed when applying for the apprenticeship.
- * Previous work experience in construction, maintenance, or a technical environment (even informal / summer work).
- * Must meet eligibility criteria to register for a SOLAS Electrical Apprenticeship

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- * Support the Health and Safety goals of the business and ensure compliance with all EHS requirements.
- * Compliance with work instructions, procedures, site rules and company policy.
- * Assist qualified electricians with the installation, maintenance, and repair of electrical systems.
- * Learn to read and interpret technical drawings, wiring diagrams, and electrical plans.
- * Install wiring, conduits, lighting systems, sockets, switches, and other electrical components.
- * Perform basic electrical tasks such as cable pulling, drilling, mounting, and testing under supervision.
- * Support with troubleshooting electrical faults and carrying out routine inspections
- * Maintain tools, equipment, and work areas in good condition.

- * Attend required off-the-job training modules (Phase 2–7) as part of the SOLAS apprenticeship framework
- * Complete logbooks, assessments, and competency documentation as required.
- * Assist in ensuring compliance with all relevant regulations, including the National Wiring Rules (I.S. 10101).
