Responsibilities of the job include -

- Diagnosing mechanical and electrical faults in light and commercial vehicles using appropriate diagnostic equipment.
- Carrying out routine servicing, preventative maintenance, and scheduled inspections in accordance with manufacturer specifications.
- Repairing or replacing defective components including engines, transmissions, braking systems, suspension, steering, and exhaust systems.
