- Tool handling
- Safety procedures
- General workshop operations

All while being supported by experienced staff.

Role Description

This is a training and work experience opportunity; no prior experience in this role is necessary. Accredited and/or sector recognised training will be provided to support your placement. Participants are eligible to participate in the WPEP QQI Work Experience Module which was developed by the Education & Training Boards in collaboration with the Department of Social Protection. This optional module will fulfil your accredited training requirements for the WPEP. Training Plan

Formal Training (Minimum 20 Hours)

- Introduction to workshop health and safety procedures
- Basic manual handling training
- Introduction to workshop tools and equipment
- Basic parts and stock identification
- Workplace communication and teamwork skills

Informal Training / On-the-Job Learning (Minimum 40 Hours)

- Observing daily workshop operations
- Learning how tools and equipment are stored and maintained
- Assisting with organising parts, tools, and materials
- Learning workshop housekeeping and safety procedures
- Observing experienced staff carrying out workshop tasks
- Becoming familiar with the workflow and organisation of a working workshop
