#### Post Summary:

The EY Assistant Professor in Financial Services will advance research, teaching, and policy engagement in the field by catalysing the existing relationships between Trinity Business School and Trinity Law School. This role reflects the shared vision of both Schools and EY to strengthen Trinity's global reputation in financial services education and research, while equipping students with the transversal skills required for careers in law, business, consultancy, and public policy.
