Atlantic Flight Training Academy (AFTA) are currently recruiting for an experienced EASA Part 66 B1.2 licenced aircraft engineer to support our aircraft maintenance department based at Cork Airport, Ireland.

AFTA operate a large fleet of Cessna 172, Diamond DA40, Diamond DA42, Vulcanair P68 & Slingsby aircraft training domestic and international cadets for some of the world's largest airlines and using the Vulcanair P68 aircraft to support our aerial survey division. The successful candidate will be part of the team that maintains this fleet to carry out routine 100hr, 200hr checks, scheduled and non-scheduled maintenance, annual checks and defect rectification. The licenced engineer will also oversee and certify maintenance work conducted by aircraft mechanics.

- Perform and certify maintenance, repair, and inspection tasks on piston-engine aircraft in accordance with Part-CAO requirements.
