Fernbrook, Good Shepherd Cork, provides emergency accommodation for up to 12 families experiencing homelessness. Cleaner role is to ensure a high standard of cleanliness, hygiene, and safety across all areas of the facility, contributing to a safe, comfortable, and dignified environment for residents, staff, and visitors.

The work involving mornings and weekend work.

Flexibility will be required during working hours.

Roles and Responsibilities;

Clean and disinfect high-touch areas frequently, including door handles, handrails, light switches, and shared equipment.

Maintain cleanliness of communal living spaces such as kitchens and kitchenettes, lounges, dining areas, laundry rooms, and play areas.

Work respectfully in occupied spaces, being mindful of residents' privacy, dignity, and personal belongings.

Assist with room turnovers by cleaning and preparing rooms for new occupants to a high standard.

Monitor and maintain stock levels of hygiene supplies, including soap, toilet paper, and cleaning products, and report shortages as needed.

Work collaboratively with support staff and maintenance teams to ensure all areas are safe and well-maintained.

Follow strict health, safety, and infection control procedures at all times.

Remain vigilant to potential health and safety risks, ensuring correct reporting and safe disposal procedures are followed.

Use personal protective equipment (PPE) appropriately and in accordance with guidelines.

Report safeguarding concerns, unusual incidents, damages, or maintenance issues promptly to the appropriate team members.
