### Application Details

#### Duties

- Support and participate in the development and provision of accessible learning materials, ensuring compatibility with assistive tools (e.g., screen readers, magnifiers, and Braille resources).
- To support in the implementation of a universal design for learning approach with all Vision Ireland Training courses. Incorporate a proactive approach to reasonable accommodation using universal design for learning to support learners to have the opportunity to engage with education in a deeper and more meaningful way.
