The successful completion of an approved Pre-Apprenticeship course or 3.

Three years' work experience gained over sixteen years of age in a relevant designated industrial activity as SOLAS shall deem acceptable.

Leaving Certificate with O6 – O1 in Maths (desirable but not required). Physics and technical drawing is beneficial

Previous construction experience is beneficial

Any additional tickets/training is beneficial

Full Driving Licence is required
