Strip, dismantle, and clean the formwork after the concrete has cured.

Repair, modify, and maintain formwork systems for reuse.

Work closely with engineers, site managers, steel fixers, concrete operatives, and other construction personnel.

Follow all site-specific quality assurance and health and safety procedures.

Maintain a clean and safe working environment at all times.

Participate in toolbox talks and site safety briefings.
