Ensuring vessels provide safe access via correctly rigged gangways, which must be monitored and maintained throughout discharge operations

Connection and disconnection of 'off-loading equipment' (hoses/loading arms/spool pieces etc.)

Monitoring and adjusting connections, as required

Ensuring valves are opened/closed for safe, efficient discharge of client products

Taking ship samples, as required

Performing line walks and repetitive checks during discharge operations

Completion of documentation as required
