Repair engines, transmissions, brakes, clutches, suspension and steering systems. Inspect, prepare and maintain heavy goods vehicles to meet CVRT requirements. Carry out emergency repairs and breakdown diagnostics where required. Replace defective parts using approved workshop procedures. Complete maintenance records accurately. Use diagnostic equipment safely. Maintain a clean and safe workshop. Work independently and within a team.

Minimum 3 years' relevant experience as an HGV, Commercial Vehicle or Heavy Vehicle Mechanic. Strong knowledge of heavy vehicle systems. Ability to interpret technical manuals. Experience using diagnostic equipment.
