Key Responsibilities:

Perform technical inspections and quality checks on incoming automotive parts, components and paint-related products to detect defects, damage or non-conformances.

Verify parts against purchase orders, technical specifications and quality standards.

Use appropriate measuring equipment and visual inspection techniques to assess dimensional accuracy, fit, finish and overall condition.

Identify, quarantine and document non-conforming or defective items and prepare clear inspection reports.

Report quality issues promptly and support corrective actions with suppliers or internal teams.

Assist in maintaining and improving quality control procedures and processes within the warehouse/motor parts operation.

Liaise with warehouse, purchasing and management staff to ensure consistent quality standards are maintained.

Support continuous improvement of quality systems and help reduce the risk of defective stock reaching customers.

Strong attention to detail and a methodical approach to technical inspection work.
