Environmental Management

- Manage the company's environmental compliance obligations, including applicable permits, licences, consents and reporting requirements.
- Liaise with the Environmental Protection Agency, Uisce Éireann, local authorities, environmental consultants and other relevant bodies.
- Manage trade-effluent requirements, environmental sampling, testing, monitoring and reporting.
- Oversee the management, storage and disposal of hazardous and non-hazardous waste.
- Monitor environmental matters including effluent, emissions, water, energy, waste, noise and chemical storage.
- Investigate environmental incidents, spills or complaints and ensure appropriate corrective actions are completed.
- Identify opportunities to reduce waste, resource consumption and the company's overall environmental impact.
