Core Job Responsibilities

Trade Support: Mix mortar, move supplies, and assist carpenters, bricklayers, or electricians.

Equipment Operation: Use hand tools, power tools, and basic light machinery safely.

Site Safety: Follow strict health rules, wear protective gear, and keep work areas clean.

Key Categories & Requirements in Ireland

Irish labor regulations categorize workers based on experience and skills, overseen by guidelines like the Workplace Relations Commission:

Category B Workers: Skilled general operatives with more than 2 years of sector experience.

Category A Workers: Experienced workers with over 4 years of experience or specialized credentials like steel fixers, scaffolders, and heavy machine operators.

Craftspersons: Fully qualified tradespeople (bricklayers, carpenters, plasterers, and painters). [

Mandatory Certifications

Safe Pass: A mandatory one-day health and safety awareness card required for all construction workers in Ireland.

Manual Handling: Training certificate for safely lifting and moving heavy items. CSCS Card:
