Job Description - This role involves working in a state-of-the-art fabrication facility equipped with the latest machinery, fabricating packaged and modular plant rooms, mechanical services pipe, bracketry, pump skids, etc. The ideal candidate will have necessary qualifications, be competent in reading and interpreting drawings, and have experience as a fitter/welder. Responsibilities include TIG and MIG welding, working with PVC Plastic pipework, fitting gearboxes, flow meters, pumps, and performing basic milling and turning. Candidates must ensure health, safety, and environmental standards are adhered to, complete system testing and documentation, and work as part of a team. Read, interpret and follow basic diagrams, engineering drawings, specifications, weld symbols, bills of materials, and other written instructions or procedures to accurately create equipment and products.
