Duties to include: Light cleaning duties at the Cathedral of Christ the King and its Parish Shop focus on routine surface cleaning and tidying. Key tasks include dusting wooden pews, retail shelves, display cases, and brass fittings; clearing burnt-out tealight cups and wax at candle stations; sweeping main aisles, doorways, and shop floors; Hoovering (vacuuming) runner mats, carpeted areas, and around cabinet bases in the sacristy; wiping high-touch areas like door handles, counters, and donation boxes; and emptying small waste bins around the sacristy and entrance porch Applicants must supply two suitable character references and be prepared to complete the online Garda vetting application process.
