Job Description - Experienced, fully qualified Electrician required for the Paving & Walling production facilities in Dunboyne, Co. Meath. The role has full responsibility for routine maintenance, servicing and fault-finding on production plant equipment and machinery, ensuring efficient operation and adherence to health and safety standards. The successful candidate will work closely with fitters, liaise with contractors and suppliers, carry out electrical installations and breakdown repairs, and prioritise preventative maintenance to support a demanding production schedule. The role forms part of a high-performance manufacturing business supplying Irish and UK customers and includes expectations for compliance with company health and safety policies and reporting of hazards and incidents.

Maintain all production machinery and electrical equipment in conjunction with on-site fitters; diagnose and repair electrical breakdowns promptly to minimise production downtime; assist with electrical installations and upgrades; liaise with external contractors and suppliers for specialised work or parts; implement and prioritise preventative maintenance programs to support production targets; lead by example on all health and safety matters, ensure compliance with company H&S policies and procedures, report hazards and incidents, and promote safe working practices across the site.

Required Qualifications - Fully qualified Electrician (QQI Level 6) with a minimum of 5 years' relevant experience. Proven experience in industrial and domestic electrical installation techniques and
