The CNC Operator is responsible for setting up and operating computer-controlled machinery to manufacture products to precise specifications. Duties include loading materials, running pre-programmed machine instructions, and monitoring equipment throughout the production process to ensure safe, efficient, and consistent operation.

The role involves inspecting completed products using precision measuring equipment to ensure they meet required specifications and quality standards. The CNC Operator will also carry out routine machine maintenance, including cleaning, tooling changes, and basic adjustments, as well as identify and troubleshoot operational issues when they arise. All work must be completed in accordance with company procedures, health and safety requirements, and established production standards. Accurate production and inspection records must also be maintained.
