The successful candidate will be involved in the safe operation of heavy machinery while contributing to the efficient day-to-day running of the quarry.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely operate heavy plant and machinery, including excavators, loading shovels, haul trucks, and mobile crushing and screening equipment.
- Monitor, load, and adjust processing equipment used in the production of aggregates, ready-mix concrete, and agricultural lime.
- Assist with the loading and dispatch of company and customer trucks, trailers, and low loaders.
- Conduct daily pre-start inspections of machinery and equipment.
- Perform routine greasing, lubrication, and basic maintenance tasks.
- Report mechanical defects and equipment issues promptly.
- Adhere to all health and safety regulations, site procedures, and PPE requirements.
- Support the efficient production and movement of materials throughout the quarry operation.

Requirements

- Existing right to work in Ireland.
- Minimum 1-2 years' experience operating heavy plant machinery within a quarry, sand and gravel pit, construction, or civil engineering environment.
- Valid EU or Irish driving licence.
- CSCS certification for relevant machinery such as 360 Excavator or Loading Shovel is highly desirable.
